

USE OF THE COTTAGES

Before your stay pick up the keys from the Church Office (10am - 1pm) unless other arrangements have been made.

During your stay you must abide by all the 'General conditions of use'.

When you are leaving clean out and extinguish all fires, sweep and mop all the areas used, clean the fridges and freezer and leave them running. Food scraps go in the compost bins but **please take** all your other rubbish with you. Ensure all the doors and windows are locked.

After your stay return the **keys** to the Church Office or letter box **no later** than the day after your stay **otherwise a late return fee of \$5 per key per day will apply. Please report any problems.**

Full payment must be received within 7 days after your stay.

General Conditions of Use

The Management may inspect the site at any reasonable time. Disregarding the conditions may lose your booking.

- No pets allowed.
- Excessive alcohol use is not permitted.
- Illegal drug use is not permitted.
- Respect your neighbours' right to privacy & quiet.
- Fires must only be lit in the places provided.
- Use compost bins not general bins for food scraps.
- Leave the cottages clean and tidy after your stay.
- **Beds/mattresses are not to be moved.**

BOOKINGS

Contact the Whyalla Uniting Church Office 0886450100 for a booking.

Appropriate forms will be forwarded.

Application Form and Deposit of \$50 for one cottage or \$100 for both must be returned within 21 days or the Booking will be cancelled without further notice.

Deposit will be refunded only for cancellations at least 4 weeks before the booked date.

Please tell the office as soon as possible, if you no longer need the booking.

Rates at 1st January 2009 (rates are subject to annual review)

Adult \$19.00 per night / Child & Student \$10.00 per night incl. GST.

Minimum overnight charge \$50 per night per Cottage.

Meeting Room is \$20 per booking incl. GST

Day Use Only: \$1.50 per person and \$50 minimum incl. GST

There are **booking limits** of 7 nights maximum during School holidays and for weekends a 2 days minimum charge applies.

Departure Time for Cottages 2.00 pm

Arrival Time for Cottages 4.30 pm.

Unless alternative arrangements are made at time of booking.

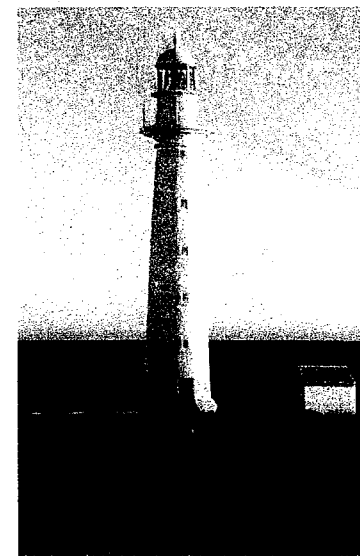

The Point Lowly Lighthouse Cottages

The Lighthouse Cottages were **built in 1883** and used for keepers and families until 1973. In the early times an oil launch brought weekly supplies from Port Pirie.

The first light was an **oil wick burner** until replaced in 1900 by a kerosene mantle type and then an automatic electric light in 1973. The lens was originally turned by a weight which was then wound back up every 2 hours!

After private use in the 1970's the Whyalla Uniting Church took over care of the cottages **for community use**. A job creation scheme in 1983 enabled renovation and the complex was also **Heritage** listed that year.

The area attractions

Local amenities include crystal clear **swimming beaches** and scenic coast, a public **playground** and **fishing** from boat, shore or rocks.

Take a **scenic coastal drive** north from the cottages, visit Whyalla Conservation Park and climb **Wild Dog Hill** for a view of the country and its flora & fauna or tour the historic **Iron Knob mines** (Restricted hours apply, contact Iron Knob Information Centre for further details)

Whyalla has a variety of facilities including a **Maritime Museum** with the corvette, HMAS Whyalla, a **One Steel** tour or visit the **Recreation Centre**, the **Foreshore** and **Marina** or one of the pleasant parks and gardens.

FACILITIES

Two cottages, which can be booked separately, have **58 beds total** with mattresses only. Each cottage has 29 beds: 3 rooms with 7 and 1 with 8.

Each cottage has **all amenities** with cooking/dining and cleaning equipment and toilet and showers suitable for disabled people. There is an electric barbecue and outside camp fire area. Wood is not supplied.

The **Meeting Room** is recommended for large groups for meals and recreation.

You will need to take: Bedding and pillows, tea-towels, dishcloths, detergent, **toilet paper**, rubbish container and first aid kit. In an emergency a phone is available from near **Santos Main Gate**.

Optional things you may want to take: Firewood or other sports equipment.
